Ngati Uenukukopako Iwi Trust has an interest in Proposed Plan Change 10 that is greater than the interest the general public has. The Trust was formed by, and represents, the people of Ngati Uenukukopako Hapu which incorporates Ruamata and Pikirangi Marae.


The Trust opposes the submission of Rotorua Lakes Council to the extent that it seeks amendments to the proposed planning framework (including objectives, policies and rules) that relate to the discharge from the Wastewater Treatment Plant to Lake Rotorua.

The particular parts of the submission the Trust oppose include (but are not limited to) submission numbers 26-4, 26-5, 26-15, 26-18 and 26-19.

The reasons for opposition are that the Trust is opposed to the Rotorua Lakes Council's proposal to discharge treated wastewater directly into Arikiroa Bay which forms part of Lake Rotorua and, therefore, does not support amendments being made to the proposed planning framework which provide for increased discharges from the Wastewater Treatment Plant.

The Trust do wish to be heard in support of its further submission.

If others make a similar submission we will consider presenting a joint case with them at any hearing.
