## NOTICE OF PERSON'S WISH TO BE PARTY TO PROCEEDINGS

Section 274, Resource Management Act 199'

TO: The Registrar Environment Court AUCKLAND

- We Ngati Tuteniu Hapu wishes to be a party to ENV-2017-AKL-000147 Ngati
   Uenukukopako lwi Trust v Bay of Plenty Regional Council which relates to
   decisions on Proposed Plan Change 10 to the Bay of Plenty Regional Land and
   Water Plan (Plan Change).
- 2. Ngati Tuteniu Hapu has an interest in the proceedings that is greater than the public generally on the grounds that:
  - (a) Ngati Tuteniu Rohe has overlapping interests with other Hapu extending from the Te Tumu o te Miromiro Stream around Lake Rotorua to the Ohau Channel, around the lake edge of Lake Rotoiti to Hells Gate, up to the peak of Rangitoto back down Te Tumu o te Miromiro Stream to Lake Rotorua.
  - (b) Ngati Tuteniu rohe includes the Ohau Channel which is the channel connecting Lake Rotorua and Lake Rotoiti and is the byway that all

water from Lake Rotorua flows to the Pacific Ocean. Ngati Tuteniu take their role of kaitiakitanga of Ohau Channel and its surrounding environments seriously and wants significant improvement in the quality of water flowing from Rotorua into Rotoiti.

- (c) Ngati Tuteniu represents 1600 registered beneficiaries as recorded on the Te Pumautanga o Te Arawa beneficiaries list. However, in the Paehinahina Mourea 1 and Tikitere A Aggregated Landblock there is over 5000 registered owners, all of whom whakapapa to Tuteniu.
- 3. Ngati Tuteniu Hapu is interested in all of the proceedings.
- 4. Ngati Tuteniu Hapu supports the relief sought and supports all the Appeal clauses in the Uenukukopako Appeal document.
- 5. Ngati Tuteniu Hapu agrees to participate in mediation or other alternative dispute resolution of the proceedings.
