NOTICE OF PERSON'S WISH TO BE PARTY TO PROCEEDINGS

Section 274, Resource Management Act 1991

TO: The Registrar

AUCKLAND

1. We Ngati Tunohopu Hapu wishes to be a party to **ENV-2017-AKL-000147 Ngati Uenukukopako Iwi Trust v Bay of Plenty Regional Council** which relates to decisions on Proposed Plan Change 10 to the Bay of Plenty Regional Land and Water Plan (**Plan Change**).
2. Ngati Tunohopu Hapu has an interest in the proceedings that is greater than the public generally on the grounds that:
 - (a) Ngati Tunohopu Rohe has overlapping interests with other Hapu extending from Sulphur Point around the lake front to Waikuta (Kauae Cemetery) up to Ngongotaha around to Toi Ohomai back to Sulphur Point.
 - (b) Ngati Tunohopu as a Koromatua of Whakaue however, has customary interests rights around Rotorua-nui-a-Kahumatamomoe and was one of six Koromatua who gifted 5000 acres to establish the city of Rotorua.

- (c) Ngati Tunohopu is based from Tunohopu (Paratehoata) Marae in Ohinemutu and represents 4300 registered beneficiaries as reported in the Pukeroa Oruawhata register.
3. Ngati Tunohopu Hapu is interested in all of the proceedings.
 4. Ngati Tunohopu Hapu supports the relief sought and supports all of the Appeal grounds laid out in the Ngati Uenukukopako Appeal document.
 5. Ngati Tunohopu Hapu agrees to participate in mediation or other alternative dispute resolution of the proceedings.
