Pg 14	Proposed Plan Change 13: Air Quality	Oppose	To allow new installation of solid wood fuel burner with emission rate of 0.6 or less within the Rotorua Airshed area	To sufficiently heat our 300 sqm home to NZ healthy home standards of >16°C we require a minimum of 2x heat pumps + heaters in each child's bedroom. This is economically an ongoing struggle and financially we are unable to provide a safe home environment for our family as power prices increase. The RLC has turned down a submission for a woodburner to be installed under the newly proposed plan. We had applied in the understanding of the prior changes and felt we fell within the new legislation. We are upset that there appeared to be no warning of this change.
