

Artist's Brief – Call for Proposals

What is the opportunity

Bay of Plenty Regional Council is constructing the Kaituna River Re-diversion and Te Awa o Ngātoroirangi / Maketū Estuary Enhancement Project. As part of the project an opportunity has been identified to create a mural on a small building that forms part of the project.

We require a suitably experienced person(s) to design and paint a mural on what is known as the Control Building.

Site Description

The building is:

- located at Ford Road, Te Tumu
- currently under construction and due to be completed in April
- on flat land with easy access
- owned by Bay of Plenty Regional Council
- constructed from concrete masonry blockwork
- a new building so no site preparation is required
- the size of the building is: 4.39m long by 3.19m wide and 2.6m high
- the southern facing wall comprises of a large door so has limited area to paint

Plans of the building will be provided.

Project Brief

The mural project has come about after discussions between the Regional Council and tangata whenua. The mural design needs to reflect the cultural and environmental values of the area.

The selected artist will:

- attend a meeting to discuss the mural and brainstorm ideas for the mural design
- draft a high quality mural design that respond to the surrounding environment, minimises graffiti and tagging and reflects the cultural and environmental values of the area
- present the design to key stakeholders (the Regional Council, tangata whenua) for approval before painting begins.

Submission of Proposals

If you are interested in this mural project, please submit the following information to the Project Coordinator either by email or post by no later than **5pm on Monday 29 April 2019**:

- a short artist's biography
- up to five images of previous work (ideally mural work, but not essential)
- a brief paragraph about why you are interested in this project

Budget

This is a fixed fee contract. The fee will be negotiated with the artist. The fee will cover:

- artist's fee
- material costs (paint, brushes, rollers etc)
- health and safety costs – ladder, face masks etc
