### **Nature of Application**

The applicant, Western Bay of Plenty District Council, is seeking consents (Consent Application Number **67481**) for the comprehensive stormwater networks for the urban settlements of Te Puke, Paengaroa, Maketu/Little Waihi and Pukehina.

The application and accompanying Catchment Management Plan were originally lodged to the Bay of Plenty Regional Council in March 2013. However, the Applicant sought time to undertake further consultation with Iwi and the community. An updated Catchment Management Plan was finalised in November 2018, which now replaces the 2013 documentation.

Consent is sought specifically for the following activities:

- Discharge stormwater to land, wetlands, and water from multiple locations within the urban areas and settlements subject to the application;
- To undertake associated land disturbing activities and activities within the Coastal Marine Area (CMA) and/or watercourses;
- To undertake maintenance activities on the stormwater network, including ongoing operations and upgrades (replacements, demolition and improvement works).

The CSC does not include stormwater discharges from the Te Puke West Structure Plan area and land zoned industrial under the Western Bay of Plenty District Plan.

Various locations throughout Te Puke and its Eastern Catchments.
