**Genera - Application to Reconsent RC62719**

Please find attached (by email) an application by Genera Limited to reconsent their current consent to discharge contaminants to air at the Port of Tauranga (RC62719).

This application is made pursuant to section 124 of the Resource Management Act (RMA) which requires that for a consent to continue to remain in effect while a replacement consent is being processed the new application must be made six months before the current consent expires. The current consent, RC62719, expires on the 30<sup>th</sup> April 2020.

Consultation has been undertaken with a number of stakeholders including tangata whenua and the Port of Tauranga Ltd (POTL) as described in the applications assessment of effects on the environment (AEE).
