Wallabies (<i>Macropus eugenii</i>)	RPMP E(2), E(3), E(4), E(5)

Rules the exemption applies to	Conditions by which the exemption are granted
RPMP E(3)	All relevant standards under the Animal Welfare Act must be adhered to when capturing, handling, holding, transporting and euthanizing wallabies.
RPMP E(3)	All wallabies captured for the trial must be transported and held in a secure manner to ensure escape is highly unlikely.
RPMP E(4)	Permission must be gained from the Ministry of Primary Industries (MPI) for an exemption under the Biosecurity Act to communicate 'unwanted organisms'.

The Bay of Plenty Regional Council hereby grants you exemption from the Regional Pest Management Plan rules listed above providing all conditions are adhered to.

The exemption may be revoked at any time at the sole discretion of the Bay of Plenty Regional Council.

This exemption is valid from 1st December 2019 until 30th November 2024.
