

LWQS Conclusions and Direction

- ▶ Clean Boat Certification strongly supported
 - ▶ Recognise the inability for BOPRC to be everywhere all of the time
 - ▶ Will be enhanced by instant fines
 - ▶ LWQS accepts the paper based alternative is a good place to start
 - ▶ LWQS requests support for the submitted change to the RPP

- ▶ Excellent support provided by MPI and NIWA, strong advocacy required to pursue common objectives

- ▶ Michelle Dedual, DOC, identified Brown Trout as only serious predator of catfish

- ▶ Lake Tarawera Complex
 - ▶ Phosphorus is increasing, TLI declining
 - ▶ Restoration Plan implementation a priority
 - ▶ Sewerage reticulation resolution required
 - ▶ Wallabies remain a serious treat to the environment
 - ▶ Support from Minister Parker to make an application to PGF
 - ▶ Guy Salmon contracted to prepare application, LWQS contributing
