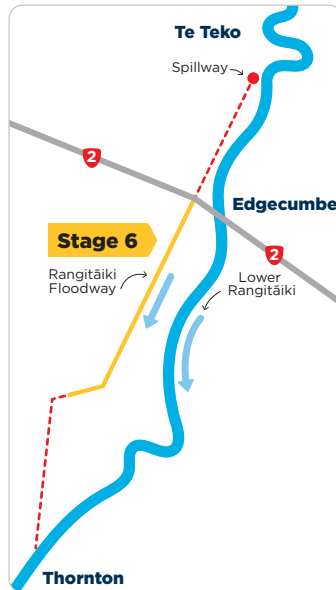
Rangitāiki Floodway Project - Stage 6
