- NGATI UENUKUKOPAKO IWI TRUST (the Trust) wishes to be a party to ENV-2020-AKL-000052 Rotorua District Council v Rotorua District Council & Bay of Plenty Regional Council, a direct referral of resource consents to authorise the proposed upgrade of the existing Rotorua Wastewater Treatment Plant and new discharge of treated wastewater – Lake Rotorua (the Applications).
- 2. The Trust made a submission about the subject matter of the proceedings

    - (iii) Will not avoid, remedy, or mitigate adverse effects on the environment.
    - (iv) Is inconsistent with and contrary to the relevant provisions of policy statements and plans, including objectives and policies in the Bay of Plenty Regional Policy Statement and Bay of Plenty Regional Natural Resources Plan which recognise and provide for matters of significance to Maori.

- (b) Without limiting the generality of the above, the Trust's other reasons that are set out in its submission dated 26 November 2018.
- 6. The Trust agrees to participate in mediation or other alternative dispute resolution of the proceedings.
