Hi Keith

Thanks for sending the further information for the regional application through last week. I have sent it on to Shane to have a look at and all going to plan I will have a look at it this afternoon.

On the Port consent, any update on the CIA? If we are still aiming for a November/December hearing we will need to get it sorted shortly. On another matter, I see that for the EPA hearings STIMBA amended the application to seek a standard of 30% recapture for log stacks. I note that the resource consent application is proposing that log stack fumigations achieve effective recapture (being the concentration of fumigant (not absorbed by the target product) within the fumigation enclosure at the beginning of the fumigation period is reduced by 80% prior to ventilation of the fumigation enclosure). I just wanted to make sure that this is still the case so that we avoid any process issues down the track if that was to change to 30%.

I'll be in touch regarding the regional application.
