## Rangitāiki Floodway Upgrade Project stopbank construction works

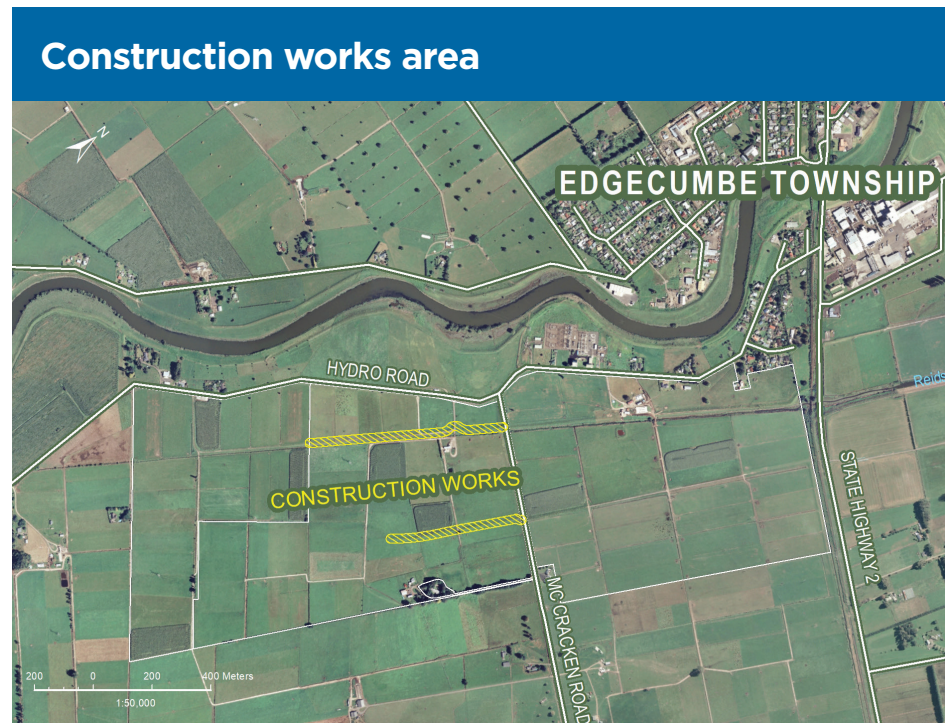
Bay of Plenty Regional Council is about to recommence construction works on Stage 7 of the Rangitāiki Floodway Upgrade Project – this is the final section located from Hydro Road to McCracken Road.

We are doing this work to improve how water travels down the Rangitāiki Floodway (Reids Central Canal) which will reduce the pressure on the stopbanks of the Rangitāiki River during large flood events.

Waiotahi Contractors Ltd have been contracted to undertake these construction works and trucks will be transporting materials to the area highlighted on the map.

Works will begin in March 2021 and are expected to be completed in June 2021. We will keep you informed if these dates change or work goes longer than expected.
