



## LAKE ROTORUA NUTRIENT MANAGEMENT - PROPOSED PLAN CHANGE 10 TO THE BAY OF PLENTY REGIONAL WATER AND LAND PLAN

Bay of Plenty Regional Council has prepared Lake Rotorua Nutrient Management - Proposed Plan Change 10 for public submissions.

The Proposed Plan Change introduces policies, rules and methods designed to limit the amount of nitrogen entering Lake Rotorua from land use.

The rules will affect rural properties in the Lake Rotorua Catchment and have been developed with input from stakeholders, technical and science experts, and the community through feedback received at public meetings, hui and information sessions.
