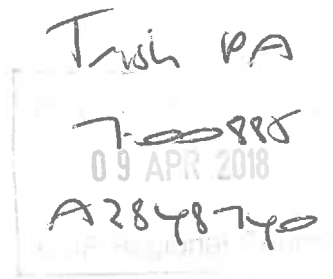

Response to AQ (Air Quality) Rule 1, General Activities:

I support this so long as it includes vehicle burnouts ON PRIVATE PROPERTY.

My name is Marian Jensen of 3 Nineteenth Avenue, Tauranga South.

For over two years local residents have had difficulty with noise and smoke pollution from 22 Botanical Road, Tauranga, where young people flat unsupervised. Often on a weekend there are up to fourteen who meet to do burnouts on the property. They are deaf to the complaints of local people and even enjoy their anger and discomfort.

Huge plumes of smoke rise from the stressed vehicle that is stationary on their property. Smoke from the burning wheels filters through the gully and invades surrounding houses. This acrid smoke lingers tenaciously for a long time.

Find enclosed a petition taken on the 18th of August, 2016 with twenty-one names objecting to this behavior.

Police are powerless to intervene as it is on private property and the drama is over before they arrive.

Pollution Control's warnings are ignored; a 24hour camera erected opposite by them was deemed an invasion of privacy by the police.

Noise Control chase a smoking gun as they arrive after the incident.

Tauranga City Council, Paul Mason and Councilor Grainger and others over the years have been of little help.

Please help us with this dilemma.
