The following application for resource consent has been received by Bay of Plenty Regional Council.

Nature of Application

Application number RM19-0774.

The Applicant has applied for resource consent to:

- Retrospectively consent for an original PVC seawall (hereby referred to as the 'original seawall') and inland second timber pole wall (hereby referred to as the 'second wall');
- Retrospectively consent for a boat ramp;
- Remove the reclamation of approximately 150 square metres (m²) of Coastal Marine Area (CMA) located at the southern end of site;
- Construct and maintain soft protection;
- Rehabilitate/enhance a coastal wetland and other planting within the CMA.

adjacent to 340E Pahoia Road, Miden, Tauranga.
