Fonterra Limited (Fonterra) has an interest in Proposed Change 6 (PC6) to the Bay of Plenty Regional Policy Statement (RPS) that is greater than the interest the general public has. Fonterra has significant assets and operational interests within the Bay of Plenty region that may be affected by PC6, including the Edgecumbe Dairy Manufacturing Site, the Omeheu Spray Irrigation Scheme, Drystore Sheds at 100 Mirrielees Road, Tauranga and a Coolstore at 100 Mirrielees Road, Tauranga.

Fonterra made submissions on PC6, listed as Submission 15.

The attached schedule sets out Fonterra's further submissions in respect of points made by other parties.

Fonterra wishes to be heard in support of this submission. If others are making a similar submission, Fonterra will consider presenting a joint case with them at the hearing.
