- Successful scholarship recipients are expected to attend Toi Moana Bay of Plenty Regional Council Komiti Māori upon invitation to formally receive award.
- Scholarship recipients agree that the Toi Moana Bay of Plenty Regional Council may include details of the recipient holder for promotional purposes.
- Applicants will be notified of outcome via email no later than 5pm Sunday 2 June 2024.
- Applicants consent to the Council contacting the named referee.
- All applications must be submitted no later than 5pm Sunday 19 May 2024.
