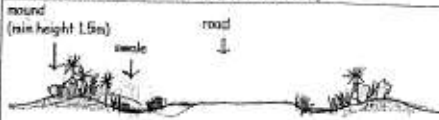
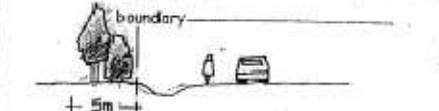


TE PUNA STATION ROAD PLANTING SECTIONS
(Planting to comply with sightline requirements at access points onto Te Puna Station Road)



CENTRAL ROADScape (10M WIDTH)

- to reinforce new ponds and open space pattern
- wider roadscape contrasts with east and west sectors



PLANTING REGIMES

	Structural planting along edges of open space corridors (native planting)
	Shelter planting on zone boundary (mix of fast growing exotics with native tree species, see section)
	Secondary planting along boundaries between land parcels as two staggered rows (mix of natives and exotics)
	Secondary planting along internal roads as two staggered rows (mix of natives and exotics)
	Wetland planting along Te Puna Station Road (see section) (native planting)
