Could you please pass on to the panel that Pirirākau Tribal Authority support Julie Shepherd's additional Statement of Evidence. In clarification of this first line of paragraph 3.45, we would like to note that in our oral tradition, Te Rangituanehu is the main source from which Te Tii and then Te Hakao emanate. We thank them for the opportunity to present yesterday.

3.45 The headwaters of Te Hakao and Te Oturu descend from Te Rangituanehu (the Minden) and all between that meets the sea. If you understand the geographical nature of our landscape without the roads, buildings, individual lots. You can understand the wider cultural complex that the site is subject to.
